The CYO Bromley Neighborhood Civic Center is a Hamilton Township Community Center that is operated by the CYO of Mercer County. We service the Bromley Neighborhood, and surrounding community. Listed below are some of the many services that we provide.

**Daily hours for office—Monday through Friday 8:00am—4:00pm**

### **Food Pantry**

The CYO Bromley Center operates a food pantry on Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9:30am—11:30am and 2:30pm—3:30pm. We are part of the USDA and NJ Food Commodity Programs. This program is designed to distribute Federal and State funded food and privately donated food to eligible, needy persons of Hamilton Township. Food distribution is monthly. Clients need to register yearly for the pantry by bringing proof of income, and ID.

### **Computer Lab**

The computer lab open daily 9:00am—3:15pm. The lab has access to the internet and all Word programs.



### **Drop-In Tutoring**

Students from Kuser, Klockner, Greenwood, and Crockett in grades 2nd through 8th may come Monday through Thursday and the 1st Friday of the month 3:45pm—5:45pm. A CYO staff member is here to work with the students on their homework. The program runs from September to June. Students need to be registered for this free program.

### **Teen Center**

Hamilton Township youth ages 9—17 can register to attend the program Monday to Thursday 6:30pm—8:30pm and Fridays 6:30pm—9:30pm. Join us for recreation, games, snacks, movie nights, and monthly trips.

### **R.O.Y.A.L Mentoring**

A weekly program for girls. They meet on Wednesday evenings at the center.

### **Summer Day Camp**

Day camp for Hamilton Township youth ages 5 to 9. Camp hours are 7:30am—5:30pm. Campers receive lunch and snack daily. Campers enjoy trips, special events, theme days and more.



### **Summer Lunch Program**

The Center participates in the USDA Summer Food Service Program as a feeding site for the youth of Hamilton Township. Children ages 5 to 18 may come to the CYO Bromley Center to receive a free lunch Monday through Friday at 1:00pm. Lunch is served outside on the playground and in the hall on inclement weather days. The CYO Bromley Center has partnered with Mercer Street Friends in this project to make sure the area children have a healthy meal during the week. Mercer Street Friends also provides us with weekend food packs as part of their Backpack food program to distribute on Fridays so the children have healthy meals on the weekends.

### **Senior Citizen Trips**

A few times during the year, the CYO will invite seniors to join us on a local trip to a place of interest, followed by lunch. Free to Hamilton Township seniors.

### **Spring Clean-Up Day**

Each Spring the CYO Bromley Center with volunteers and the area neighbors clean-up the Bromley Park and surrounding areas in the neighborhood.



### **Hall Rentals**

Our hall is available on weekends for Birthday Parties, Bridal/Baby Showers, etc. Contact the office for details and costs.

### **Special Events**

#### **Halloween Party /Parade**

Always a fun day for the youth of the neighborhood. Each year we gather at the Fire House to start the parade. When the Trick or Treaters arrive at the CYO Bromley Center, they are invited in for Pizza, Juice, and Prizes.



#### **Thanksgiving Dinner**

With the help of many volunteers and sponsors we provide an Annual Thanksgiving Dinner for our Food Pantry Clients. We try to secure enough donations of turkeys and food to distribute food baskets to each family that attends the dinner.

#### **Children's Holiday Party**

Each year we celebrate the Holidays with a party for children from Greenwood, Klockner, and Kuser Schools in grades Pre-K to 2nd who are part of the Federal and State Funded Lunch Program. Each child receives a gift from Santa and families enjoy pizza, snacks, and a DJ.
